Ross-on-Wye Community Garden is a vital service in the heart of our town. It's more than just a garden – it's a place for adults, children and young people, for sharing and connecting with each other, for learning about horticulture and our environment, and for improving physical and mental health.

At the garden we run therapeutic gardening sessions for adults with learning disabilities and mental health needs and schoolchildren, as well as our essential Zero Waste Stall which provides free food for local people and families who would otherwise struggle.

People who visit the garden tell us what it means to them:

"I know it's good for me to come here and be around people and in nature." (service user with mental health needs)

"I have never seen the children so calm and happy in the classroom as they've been here." (teaching assistant during school session)

"I rely on the Zero Waste Stall to help me feed my family every month." (Zero Waste Stall customer)

Running this community facility requires constant work, maintenance, and resources.
